October 2023 General Information:

- 1. <u>75/25 Daily Drawing</u>: Due to a change in the Federal tax laws the next 75/25 daily drawing payout will be capped at \$599.00.
- <u>Happy Hour Pricing</u>: Canteen happy hour price time runs from 5pm to 7pm Monday through Friday ONLY. The Canteen Bar Tender will not accept any happy hour drink vouchers AFTER 7pm. If you have happy hour drink vouchers, please utilize them only during happy hour timeframes.
- 3. *Front Door Access:* The Post Home main entrance is now accessed using a Fob. To get your Fob, contact Theresa, Curtis, or Craig!
- 4. <u>Locker Dues</u>: Commencing 01 JAN 2023 all locker fees are due for the year, to be paid yearly each calendar year. Also, commencing 01 JAN 2023 all locker dues will increase to \$20.00 a year. Pay your locker dues to the Canteen Manager or put your dues in an envelope and give them to the on-duty Bar Tender.
- 5. <u>Food Handler Cards</u>: Anyone making, cooking, or serving food in the Post Home is required to have a valid Virginia Food Handler Card. Get yours now at <u>www.efoodhandlers.com</u>
